





Why Do I Have to Pay???

There are many A.A./Al-Anon round-ups, conferences and conventions held around the world. One of the most common misconceptions of these gatherings is that they are official A.A./Al-Anon “meetings,” and since “*there are no dues or fees for A.A./Al-Anon membership...*,” there should be no fees to attend.

Please remember that our SFVAA Convention is an “event,” not a regular meeting. It requires *literally* months of planning, preparation, and financial resources to present.

Since this event is held in a hotel, there is a charge for the use of the facilities. Along with the facility charge, the hotel requires that the group purchase coffee and food onsite. Other expenses include travel and lodging for convention speakers, printing of flyers, tickets, schedules and programs, postage and supplies.

While an event of this magnitude requires a substantial amount of money, our SFVAA Convention is nevertheless self-supporting. No group monies are ever used to pay for this event, and no baskets are passed.

The cost of the event is paid almost exclusively through the registration fee of the participants.

The ideal goal for any committee of such an event is simply to break even. Therefore, the registration fee is nominal compared to a weekend’s worth of entertainment anywhere else, and certainly when we consider the price we were willing to pay for our last drink.

Attendance is voluntary, and as responsible A.A. / Al-Anon members who are “self-supporting,” we *pay our own way.*





2026 SFVAA Convention Map


FIRST FLOOR
